Introduction to the College

Government Degree College Chaubattakhal (Pauri Garhwal) Uttarakhand was established on 11 October 1979 by then Government of Uttar Pradesh to provide higher education in the hilly districts of the state. The college got its affiliation from Sri Dev Suman Uttarakhand University, Badshahithal, Tehri (Garhwal), Uttarakhand on 4th April 2018. It got its UGC Recognition under Section 2 (f) & 12 (B) of the UGC Act, 1956 under the head 'Government Colleges teaching up to Bachelor's Degree on 26th February 2010. The college started with introducing five departments (Political Science, Hindi, Economics, English, and Geography). In 2005, the college started Bachelor's of Science with 5 subjects (Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, Maths, and Physics). Recently in 2022, the college was granted permission to introduce two more subjects namely, History and Sanskrit in B.A course. The total student strength of the college in the academic session 2022-2023 was 216. In 2022-2023, the college had 1 professor, 7 Assistant Professors, 2 Guest Faculties, and the head of the college, the Principal (Professor). The college is running various courses like the Distance Education Centre under Uttarakhand Open University.

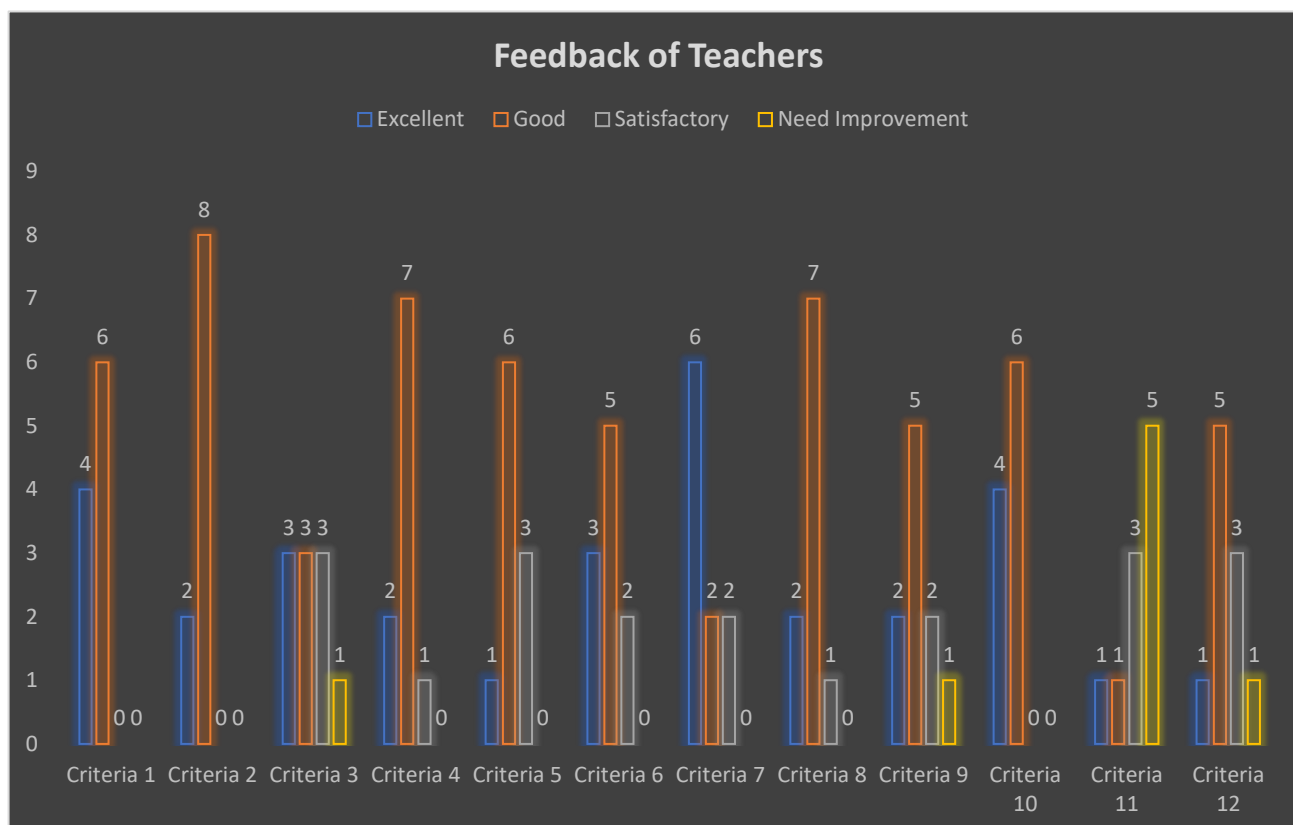
This is an effort from the college to collect feedback from students, teachers, and alumni regarding the college and its curriculum so that the college can design more students' friendly guidelines.

4. Funds and other facilities are to be provided by the university to the teachers in affiliated colleges to encourage them to upgrade their skills and

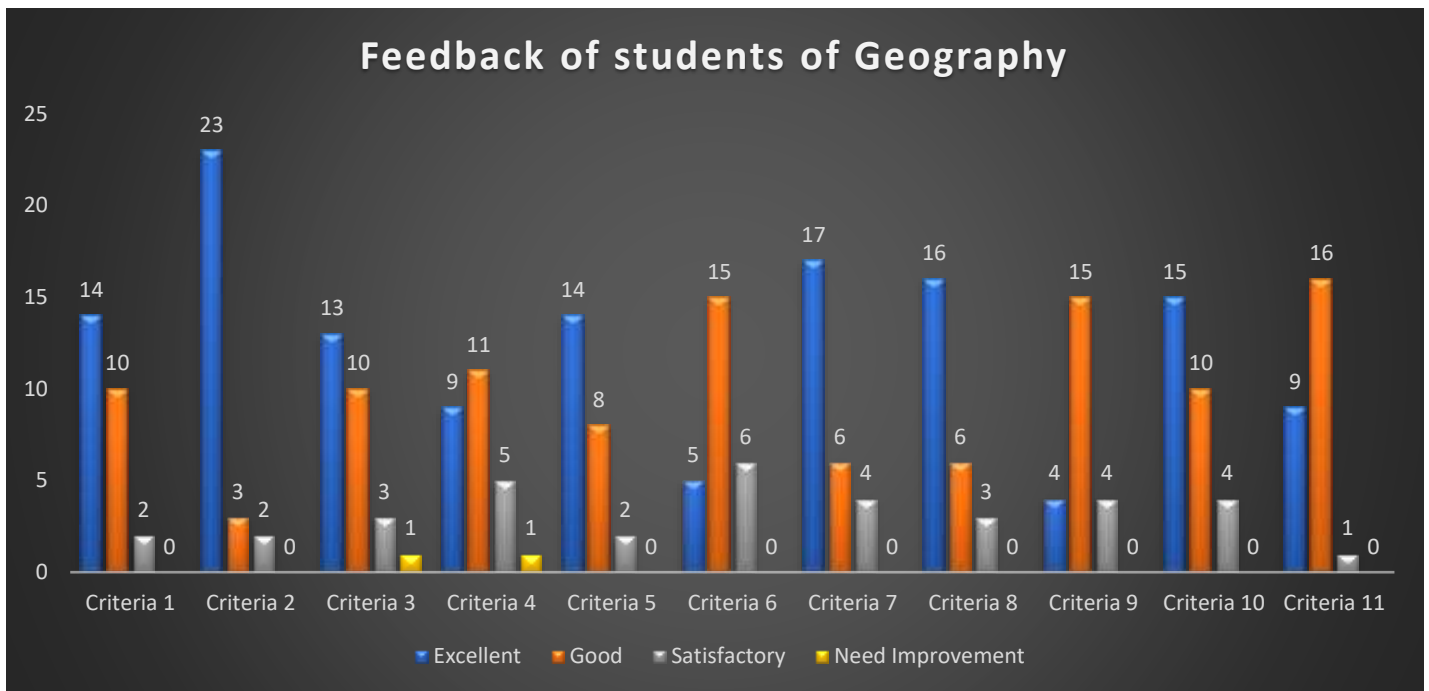
participate in national and international conferences. Currently, no such support is provided by the university.

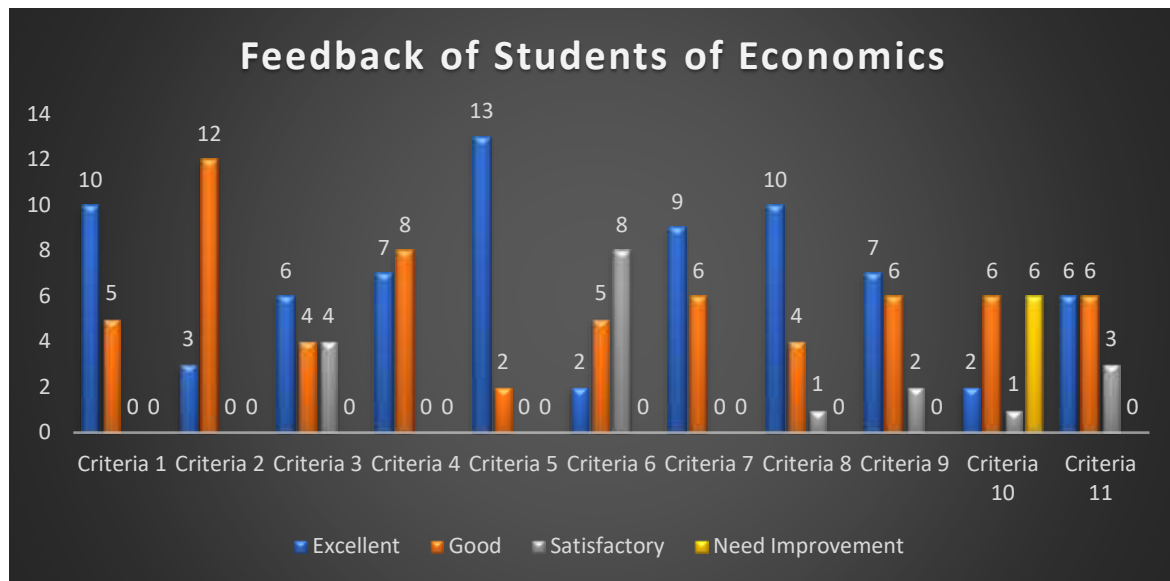

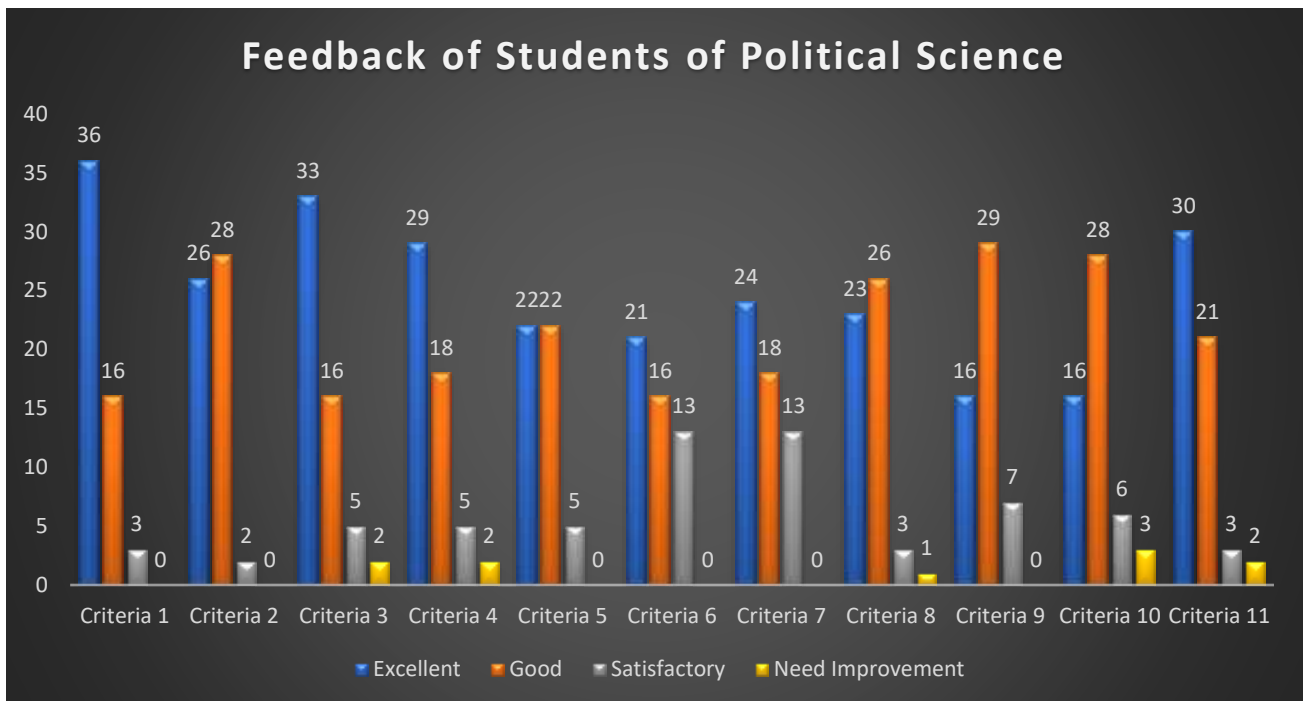

Political Science



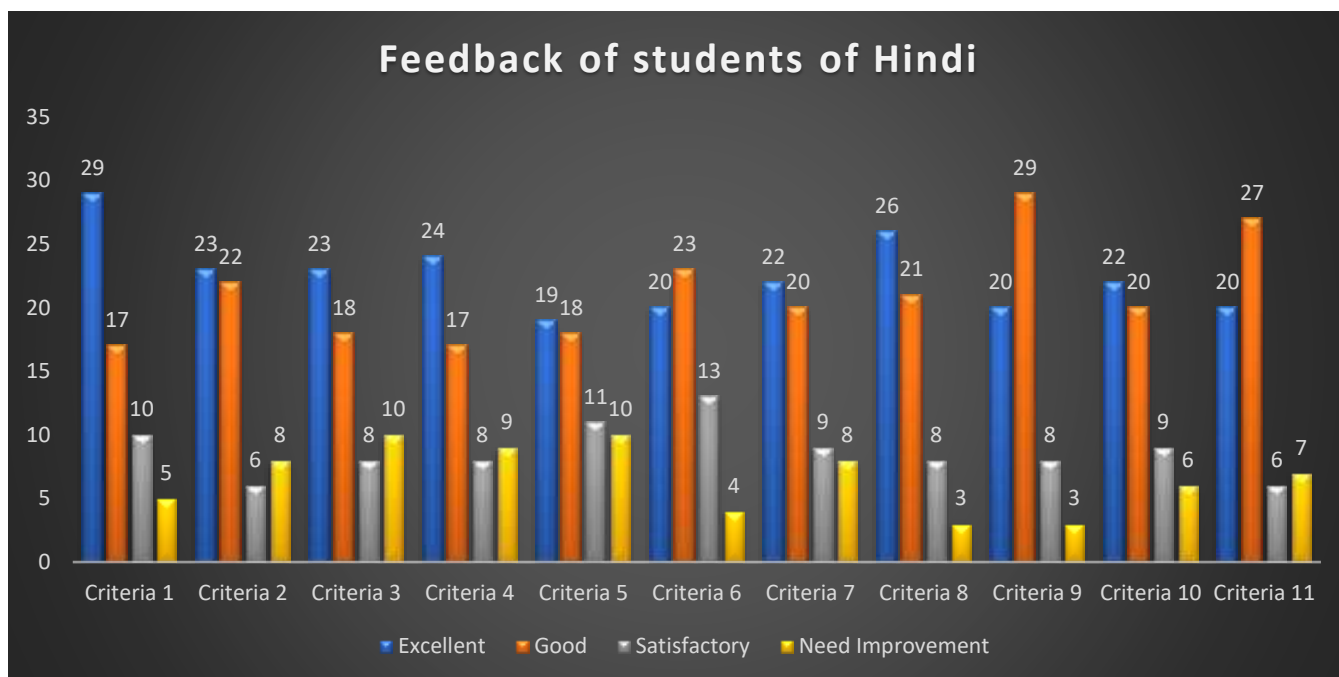

Hindi



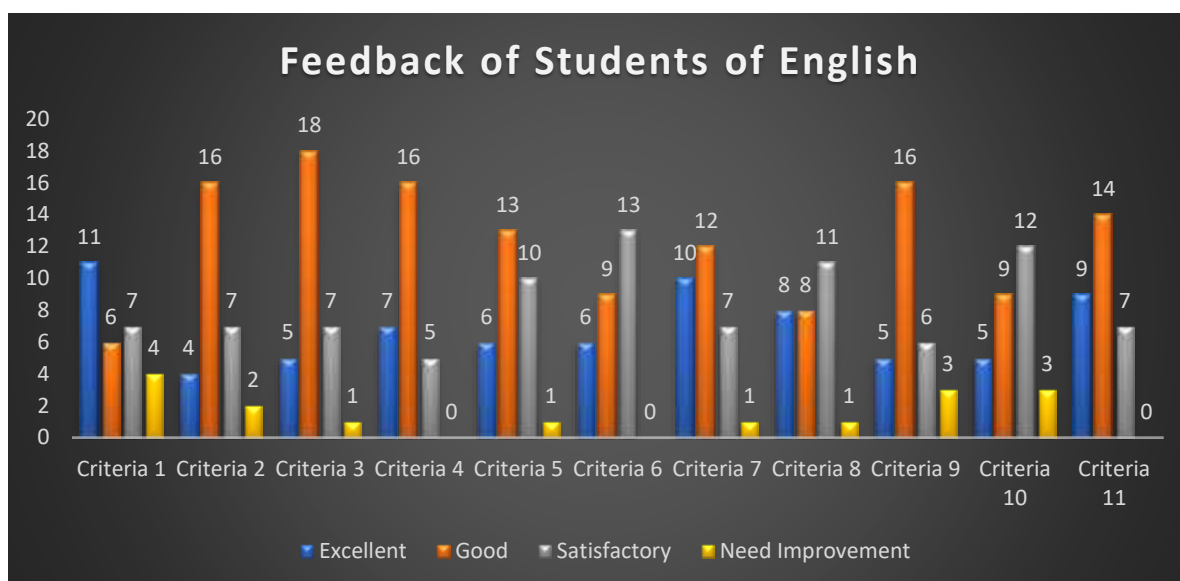

English



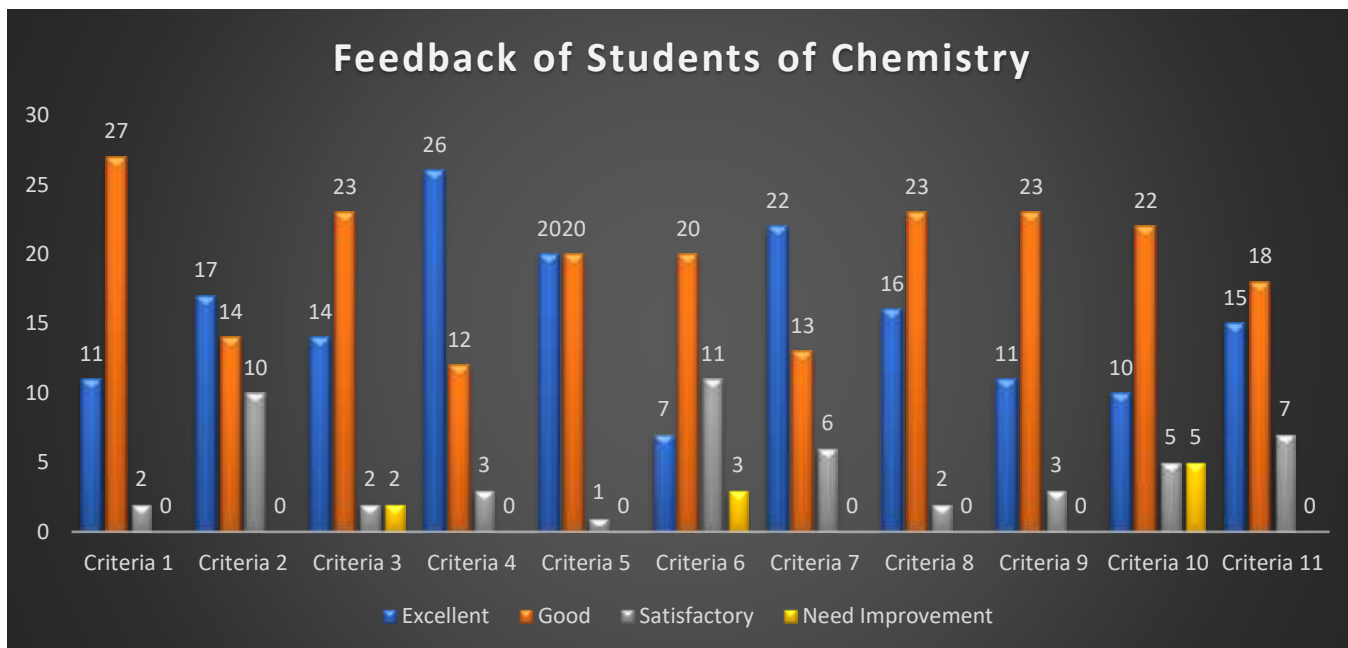

Chemistry



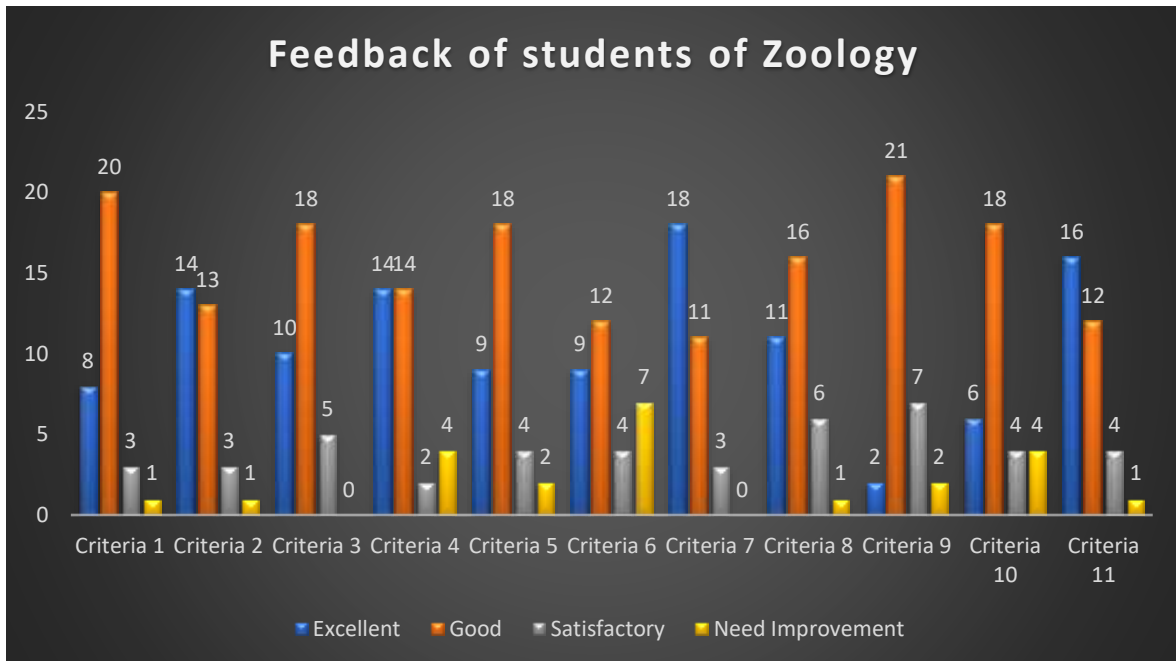

Result



Analysis

1. Syllabus is not according to the job requirements of the alumni and hence it don't enhance the practical skills directly.
2. Although the syllabus was not practical yet it imparted basic knowledge regarding the subject and given values and ethics to the graduated students.

Action Taken by College

1. Since the last few years, the college administration is regularly pursuing the Higher Education Directorate for funds and other support so that basic facilities can be established in the college.
2. As a result, lots of new buildings and blocks were added to the college. Now the college has a separate Arts and Science block, a separate administrative building, separate washrooms for girls and boys with a 24*7 water supply facility, and new seminar hall.
3. Currently, the college does not have teachers of Sanskrit and Mathematics. The college has sent multiple requests to Directorate for the appointment of a new faculty.
4. College also collaborated with various NGOs like Hans Foundation which has provided books for the library and college uniforms for underprivileged students.
5. The faculty of the college has always been requested to participate in training programs and as a result this year 3 faculties finished their refresher program.
6. College has collaborated with the local community for various awareness programs, especially in 7 days camp NSS.
7. In order to have a proper representation of students in the college decision-making process, after 2 years (due to COVID) college conducted elections of the student union. This student union has conducted various competitions for the students like poster, debate, essay, and rangoli competitions.
8. College also conducted the annual sports event in December 2022.
9. College has constructed the water reservoir for rain water harvesting at the campus.
10. Currently college is also constructing new fully equipped library with reading rooms for the students of college. The existing library has added 417 books this year in its stock.
