## **Introduction to the College**

Government Degree College Chaubattakhal (Pauri Garhwal) Uttarakhand was established on 11 October 1979 by then Government of Uttar Pradesh to provide higher education in the hilly districts of the state. The college was affiliated with Sri Dev Suman Uttarakhand University, Badshahithal, Tehri (Garhwal), Uttarakhand on 4<sup>th</sup> April 2018. It got its UGC Recognition under Section 2 (f) & 12 (B) of the UGC Act, 1956 under the head 'Government Colleges teaching up to Bachelor's Degree on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2010. The college started with introducing five departments (Political Science, Hindi, Economics, English, and Geography). In 2005, the college started Bachelor's of Science with 5 subjects (Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, Maths, and Physics). In 2022, the college was granted permission to introduce two more subjects namely, History and Sanskrit in B.A course. The total student strength of the college in the academic session 2023-2024 was 191. In 2022-2023, the college had 1 professor, 8 Assistant Professors, and 2 Guest Faculties. The college runs various courses, such as the Distance Education Centre under Uttarakhand Open University.

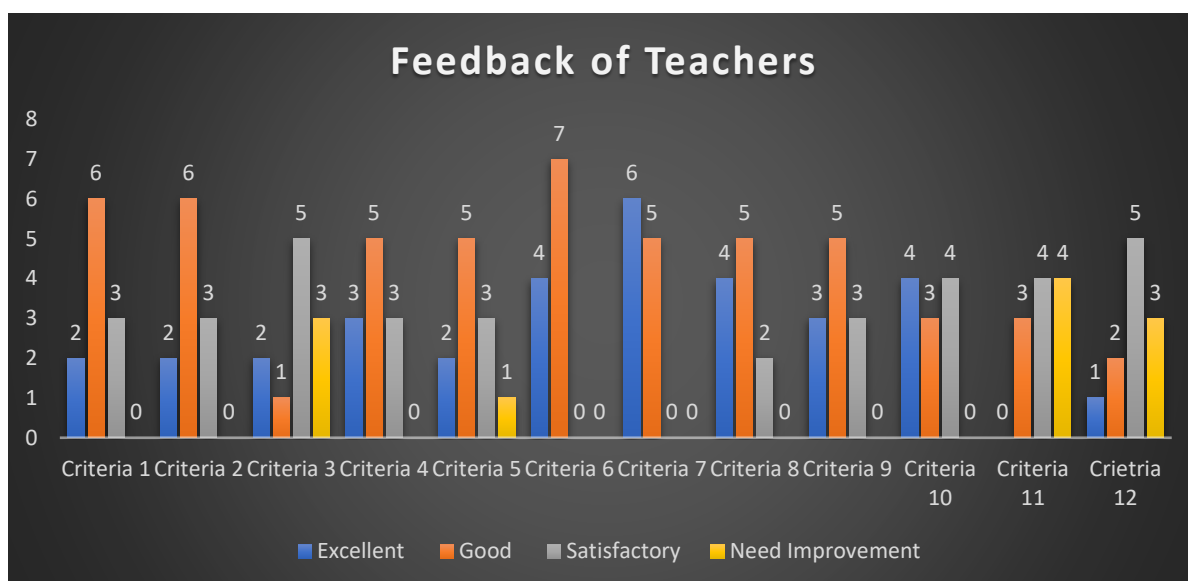
This is an effort by the college to collect feedback from students, teachers, and alumni regarding the college and its curriculum so that the college can design more student-friendly guidelines.

## Areas of Improvement

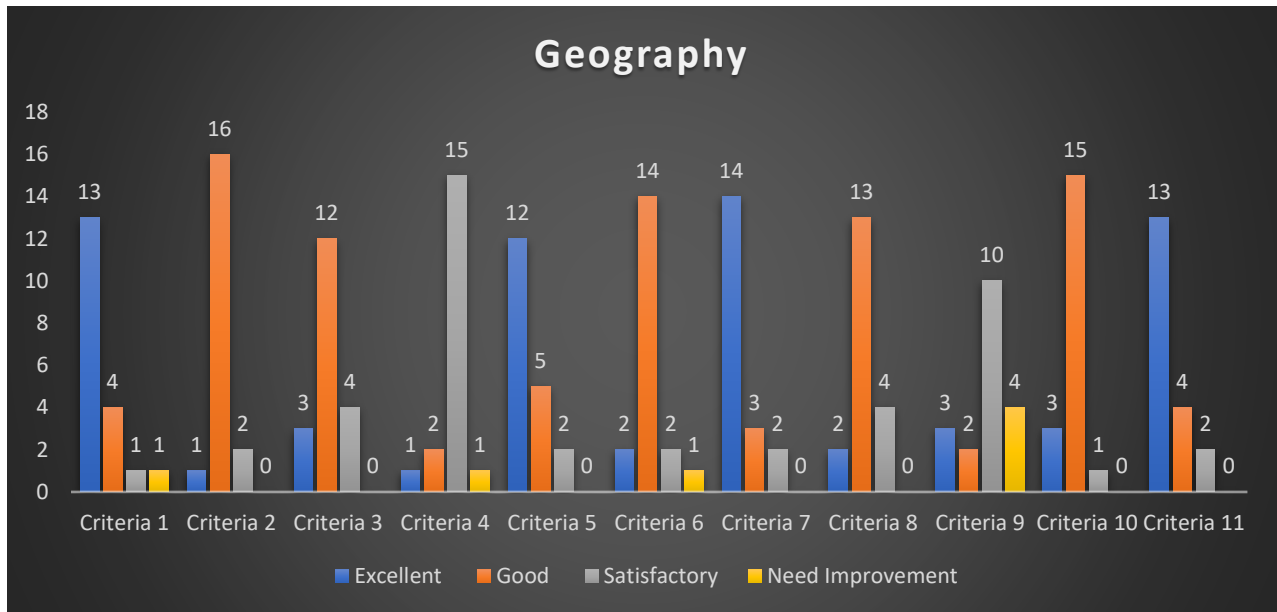
1. Library resources need to be improved according to new syllabus under NEP 2020.

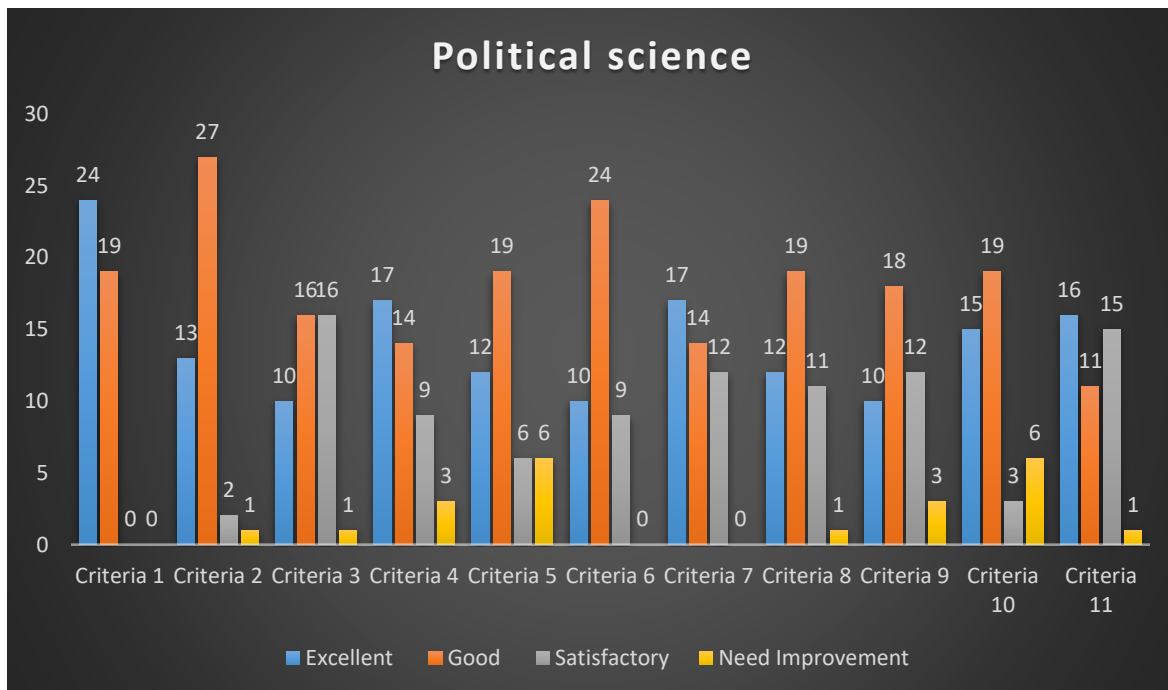

# Political Science



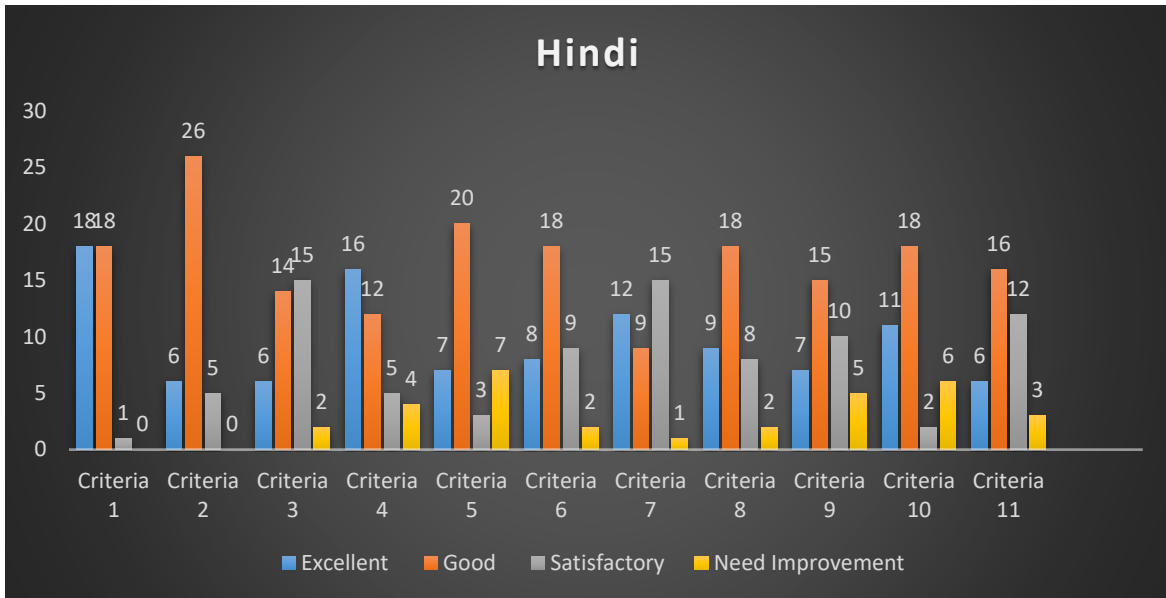

# Hindi



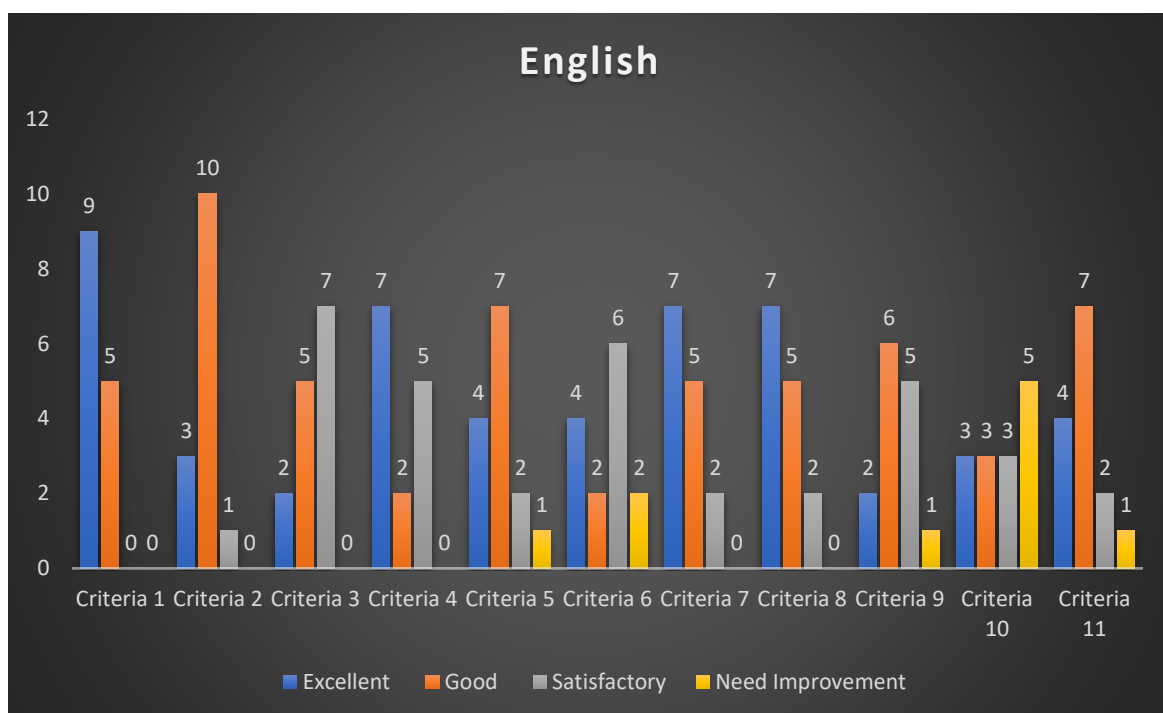

## English



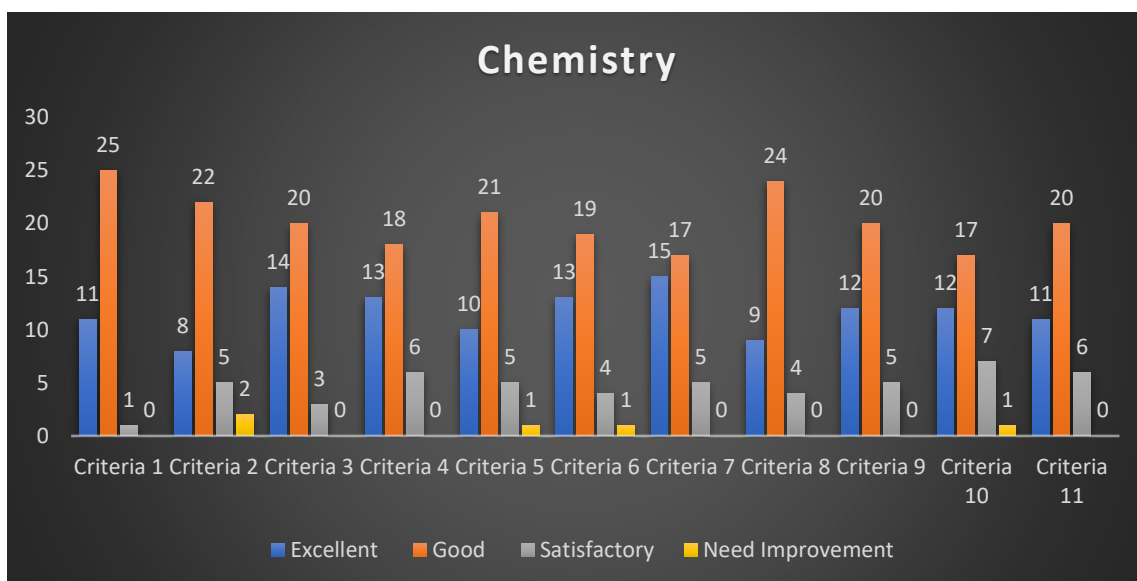

# Chemistry



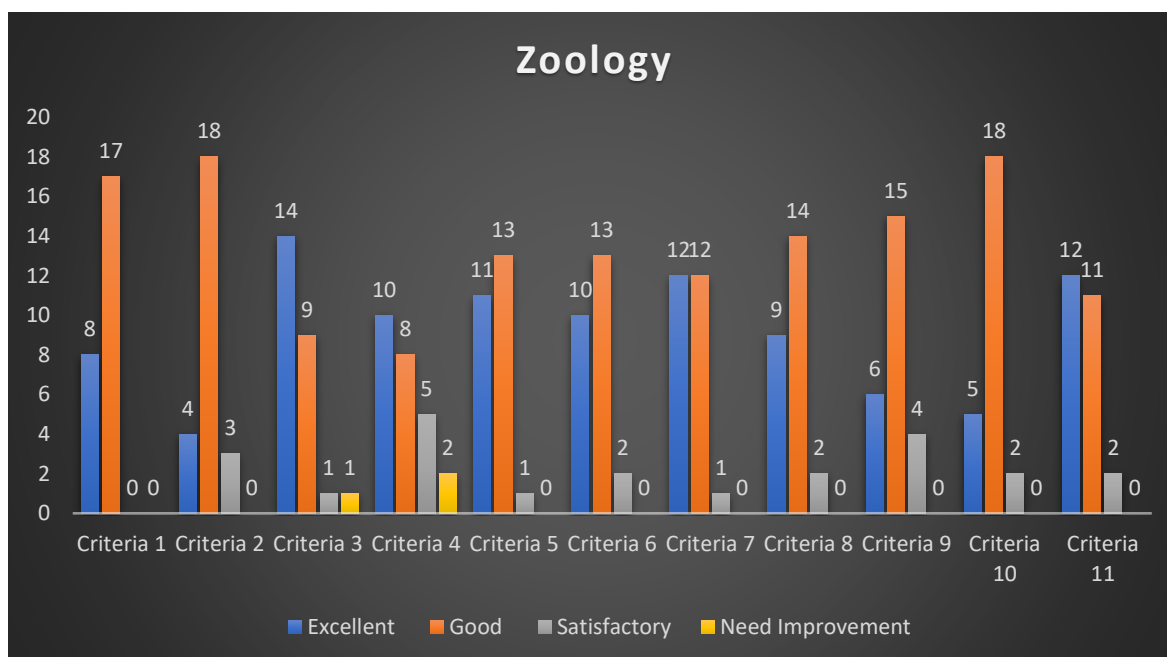

2. Although the syllabus was not practical yet it imparted basic knowledge regarding the subject and given values and ethics to the graduated students.

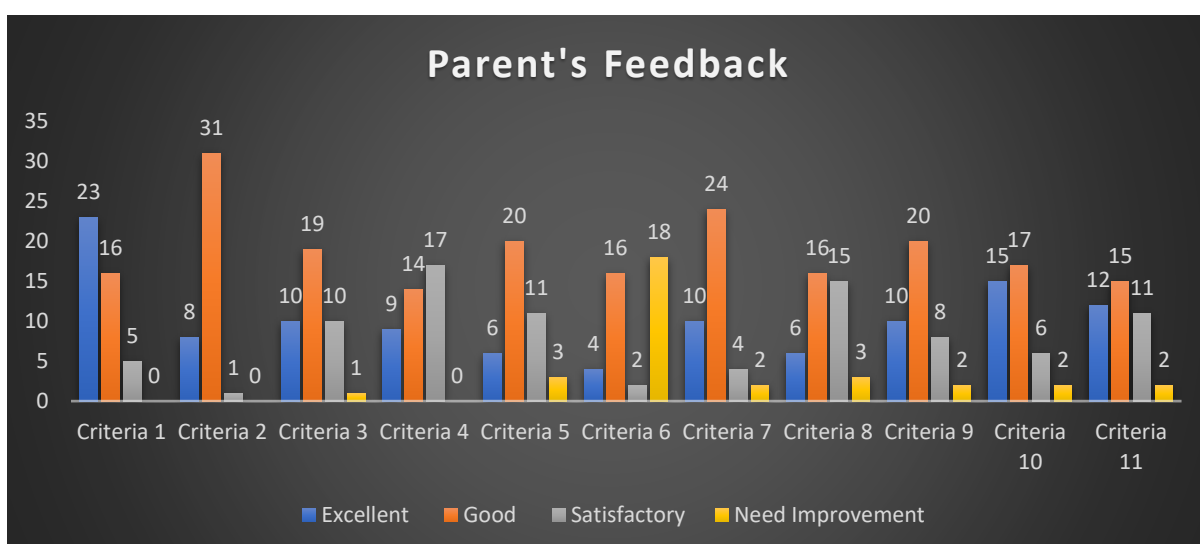

### Results



### Analysis

1. Parents are overall satisfied with the quality of education provided to their wards in the college.
2. Parents find faculty and college administration help and have admitted the increase in intellect and knowledge levels of their wards after their admission to the college.
3. Parents are not satisfied with the IT infrastructure and Library of the college.

### **Action Taken by College**

1. Since the last few years, the college administration is regularly pursuing the Higher Education Directorate for funds and other support so that basic facilities can be established in the college.
2. As a result, lots of new buildings and blocks were added to the college. Now the college has a separate Arts and Science block, a separate administrative building, separate washrooms for girls and boys with a 24\*7 water supply facility, and new seminar hall.
3. Currently, the college does not have a teacher of Sanskrit. The college has sent multiple requests to the Directorate for the appointment of a new faculty.
4. The college also collaborated with various NGOs like Hans Foundation which has provided books for the library and college uniforms for underprivileged students.
5. The college faculty has always been requested to participate in training programs; as a result, this year 2 faculties finished their orientation and refresher program.

6. College has collaborated with the local community for various awareness programs, especially in 7 days camp NSS.
7. To have a proper representation of students in the college decision-making process, the College conducted elections of the student union in October 2023. This student union has conducted various competitions for the students like poster, debate, essay, and rangoli competitions.
8. College also conducted a skill development workshop for the students of the college in March 2024.
9. Currently college is also constructing a new fully equipped library with reading rooms for the students of the college.
